#### **Board of Education Updates**

The January 16th Board of Education meeting will include key agenda items such as:

#### **Priority Area 3: Funding and Facilities**

#### Facility Updates

- •Mold Remediation: The Pre-K classroom was successfully treated for mold, and students returned on November 19th.
- •Gas Leak Repair: An exterior gas leak on the elementary campus was repaired in November, ensuring student safety and comfort.

#### **Printer Installation Update**

Representatives from GFI installed our updated printers on December 18th. We are excited about the improvements this upgrade will bring to both our staff and students.

Our new scoreboard and video board have been delivered to InSight, who will handle the installation. We've partnered with **Hale Electric** to provide the necessary electrical services, and the project is progressing well.

#### **Timeline Updates:**

The project is set to begin on December 20th, with a completion date of January 10th. Due to this installation, junior high basketball games will be moved to the Elementary gym during this period. Staff training for the scoreboard is scheduled to start by January 16th.

#### How to receive inclement weather notifications via Infinite Campus

- To be notified of school cancellations or late starts, you must have a portal account through Infinite Campus.
- Parents and guardians with students in the district should have received an email from Infinite Campus with an activation link and activation code to set up a parent portal.

• If you have not received that email, please check first to see if the email was delivered to your spam/ junk mail folder. If you have not received an email, please contact your child's school office (Elementary – Carol Koestner at 573-782-4814. High School – Devona Maharas at 573-782-3313). If you do not have a child in the district and would like to receive notifications, please contact Kristen Heidbreder at kheidbreder@coler1indians.org and request an Infinite Campus portal account. To request an Infinite Campus portal account, you will need to provide the email address and cell phone number you want the notification to go to.

Important note: Parents and guardians must have a parent portal in Infinite Campus and opt into the service in order to receive district messages. We recommend that all parents and guardians check their contact preferences in Infinite Campus to ensure they receive messages through their preferred method. To check your preferences, log in to your parent portal and follow the steps below.

Select "settings".



Infinite Campus's Campus Parent app offers a wide array of features to keep students and parents/ guardians informed. Here is a quick overview of its useful functions:

- Access transcripts and grade cards: Log into the portal and navigate to the "Documents" section in the menu to view student records.
- Stay Updated on Academic Progress:
  - -Notifications for grade updates and assignments can be enabled.
  - —Tap the person icon in the upper right-hand corner, go to Profile Options, select Settings, and then choose Notification Settings.
  - -Toggle the option for Grades and Assignment Updates to ensure you're always informed
